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In the 33rd edition of Energy Statistics 2026, the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) has, inter-alia made the following improvements:

- i. Inclusion of statistics on 'Credit flow to energy-sector', 'International energy scenario' and 'international marine and aviation bunker' data;
- ii. Alignment of end-use consuming sectors of all the energy-commodities with International standards;
- iii. Addressing data-gaps on industry-wise consumption of Coal and Electricity.
