

Central Bureau of Communication Nagpur to Organise Multimedia Photo Exhibition on 12 Years of Government Achievements and VB-G RAM-G Act 2025 in Bhandara

Three-day multimedia exhibition from August 13–15 to be inaugurated on Thursday
