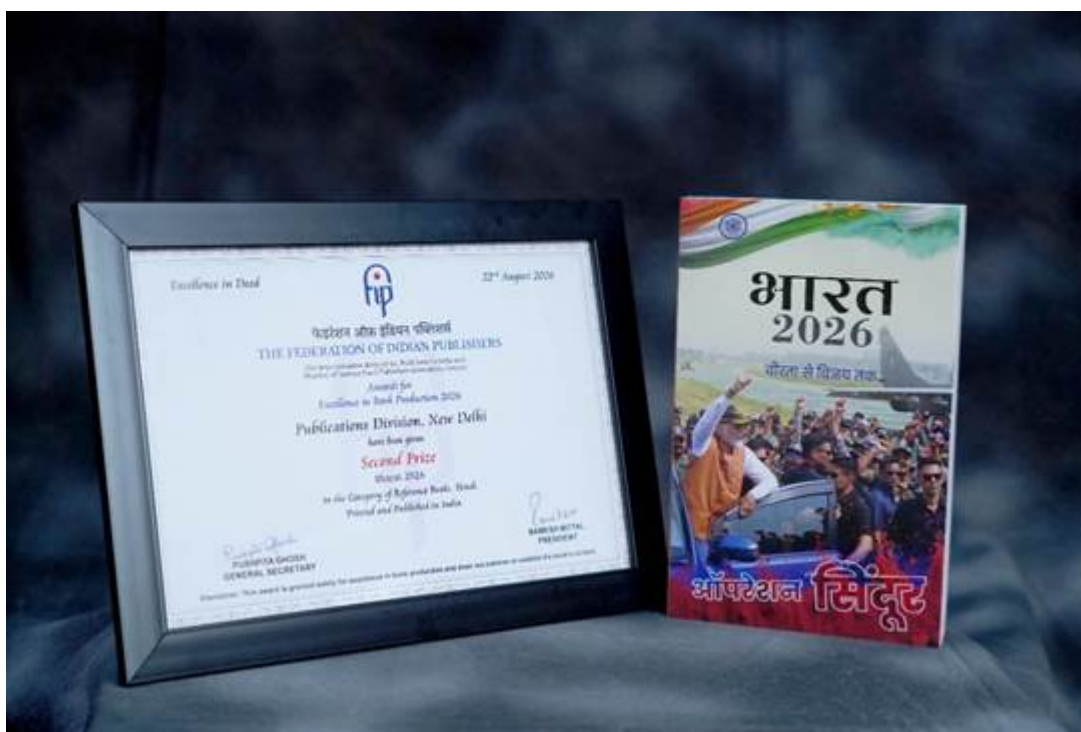
### **Publications Securing Second Prizes**

- **Ajkal Urdu – July 2026** received the Third Prize in the Journals & House Magazines, Indian Languages (Urdu) category.

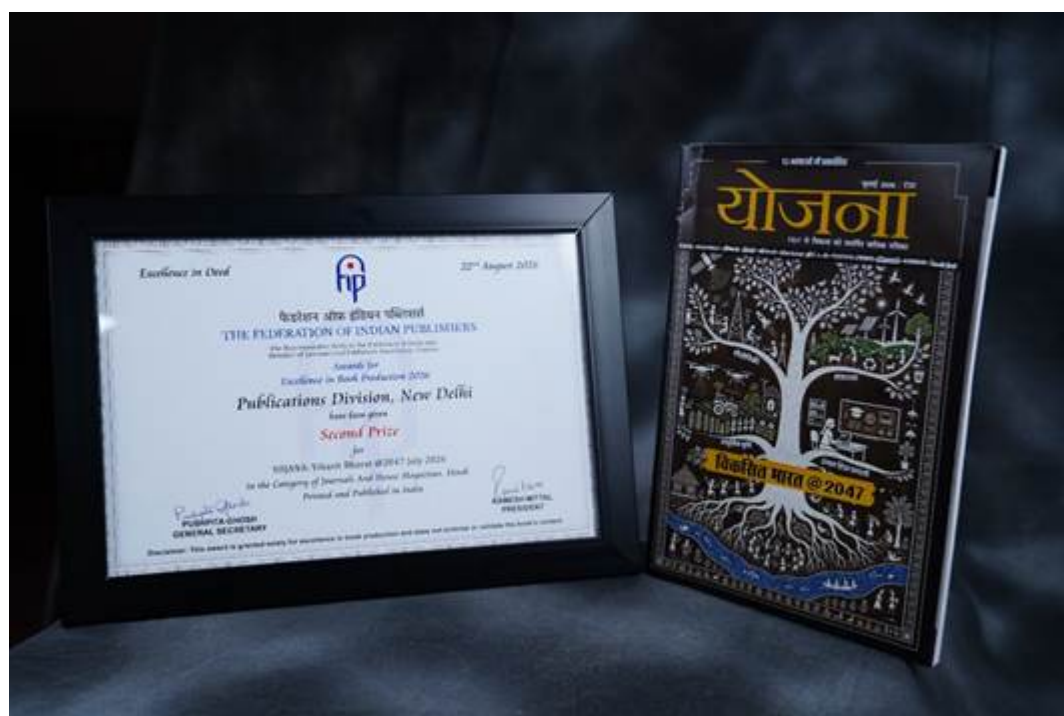
