



# Prime Minister Conferred with “Oliy Darajali Do’sstlik” Order, Uzbekistan’s highest honour for foreign leaders

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Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi was today conferred with the “Oliy Darajali Do’sstlik” Order (Order of Highest Friendship) by the President of Uzbekistan, H.E.
