

NIFT joint convocation 2026 held in presence of Hon'ble President of India

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A total of 315 graduating students from the National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT), Mumbai participated in the NIFT Joint Convocation 2026 held at Yashobhoomi, New Delhi, on 31 August 2026. The Convocation brought together graduating students from 18 NIFT campuses across the country to celebrate their academic achievements and mark the beginning of their professional journeys.

The Convocation was graced by the Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, as the Chief Guest. The Hon'ble Union Minister of Textiles, Shri Giriraj Singh; Secretary (Textiles), Smt. Neelam Shami Rao; Director General, NIFT, Smt.
