



Mumbai Port Authority Hosts Seychelles Parliamentary Delegation at Mumbai International Cruise Terminal

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Mumbai Port Authority hosted a Parliamentary Delegation from Seychelles at the Mumbai International Cruise Terminal today as part of the delegation's official visit to Mumbai under the bilateral parliamentary exchange programme.

The delegation was led by Hon'ble Azarel Ernesta, Speaker of the National Assembly of Seychelles. The visiting delegation was received by Shri Adesh Titarmare, IAS, Deputy Chairperson, Mumbai Port Authority, along with senior officials of the Port.

The delegation was briefed about the facilities and operations of the Mumbai International Cruise Terminal, including passenger arrival and departure processes.
