



INS MYSORE ARRIVES AT LUMUT, MALAYSIA FOR THE 4th EDITION OF EXERCISE SAMUDRA LAKSAMANA

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As part of the Indian Navy's Operational Deployment, INS Mysore arrived at Lumut, Malaysia, on **09 Sep 2026** to participate in the 4th edition of bilateral maritime exercise 'Samudra Laksamana' between the Indian Navy and the Royal Malaysian Navy.

The ship and her crew were warmly welcomed by personnel of the Royal Malaysian Navy and officials from the High Commission of India in Malaysia.

Exercise Samudra Laksamana comprises of **professional engagements in harbour and at sea, including cross-deck visits, operational interactions and sporting engagements**. These activities will provide opportunities for personnel of both navies to exchange professional experiences, enhance interoperability and foster greater mutual understanding.
