



Prime Minister meets with the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan on the sidelines of the BRICS Summit in New Delhi

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Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi met with the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan, H.E. Mr. Kassym-Jomart Tokayev, today on the sidelines of the 18th BRICS Summit in New Delhi.
