

AIIMS Nagpur Resident Wins Three Medals at National Masters Swimming Championship

Dr Anuva Kapoor Qualifies for 2nd Asian Masters Swimming Championship

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The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Nagpur, congratulated Dr Anuva Kapoor, final-year MD resident in Community Medicine, on winning three medals at the 22nd National Masters Swimming Championship held at Champion Aquatics Academy, Bahadurgarh, Haryana, from September 11 to 13, 2026.
