**The Social Security (Contributions) (Re-rating)
Consequential Amendment Regulations 2026**

The Treasury make these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 117(1) and 175(3) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992⁽¹⁾ and by sections 117(1) and 171(3) and (10) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits (Northern Ireland) Act 1992⁽²⁾.

The Secretary of State and the Department of Communities concur in the making of these Regulations.

These Regulations contain only provisions consequential on the making of an instrument under section 141 of the Social Security Administration Act 1992⁽³⁾ and section 129 of the Social Security Administration (Northern Ireland) Act 1992⁽⁴⁾.

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Contributions) (Re-rating) Consequential Amendment Regulations 2026.

The Department for Social Development was renamed the Department of Communities by section 1(7) of the Departments Act (Northern Ireland) 2016 (c. 5 (N.I.)).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations 2001 ([S.I. 2001/1004](#)) (“the Contributions Regulations”) with effect from 6th April 2026. They are made in consequence of annual regulations setting the rate at which Class 2 National Insurance contributions are payable which are made under section 141 of the Social Security Administration Act [1992 \(c. 5\)](#) and section 129 of the Social Security Administration (Northern Ireland) Act [1992 \(c. 8\)](#).

Regulation 2 amends regulation 125(c) of the Contributions Regulations by increasing the special rate of any Class 2 National Insurance contribution payable by share fishermen from £4.15 to £4.30.

A Tax Information and Impact Note has not been prepared for this instrument as it contains no substantive changes to tax policy.
